




## MEASURING OUR IMPACT


To assess the impact of our fabrics and all their composition types and blends, we're using tools such as the **Higg MSI** (Materials Sustainability Index). This gives us important feedback on where to improve how our products are impacting the environment.

When put another way, GRS yarns are also ensuring that post-consumer waste is kept out of landfill. GRS fabrics are made from plastic waste such as used PET bottles, and on average 25 one litre bottles are used per 1kg of GRS yarn produced.

## LET'S UNPACK SOME OF THE STANDARDS OUR FIBREGUARD FABRICS ARE CERTIFIED WITH:

All FibreGuard fabrics are manufactured and certified under the STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX®, guaranteeing that they won't release any harmful finishes or chemicals into the environment and are completely safe for contact with you, your children and your pets. This also means that all FibreGuard fabrics are completely PFAS-free.

Some of our beautiful collections are Global Recycled Standard (GRS) and/or Organic Content Standard (OCS) certified.

The Global Recycled Standard (GRS) verifies that the fabric is produced using recycled waste, such as PET bottles. If a collection is labelled as GRS certified, 50% or more of its composition contains recycled materials. This means we are keeping plastic waste out of landfill, and creating beautiful FibreGuard fabrics instead.

This standard is audited on an annual basis by assessing production, trading and manufacturing processes, ensuring the recycled content is authentic. Our unique GRS number is 1036513.

The **Organic Content Standard (OCS)** is a certification awarded to goods that are guaranteed as containing organic content such as organic cotton. Based on their composition, fabric is either awarded the 'Organic Content Standard 100' for fabrics containing more than 95% organic fibre, or the 'OCS Blended – Organic Content Standard' for fabrics containing between 5% and 95% organic fibre. Our unique OCS number is 1036513.

ISO 14001 establishes criteria for an environmental management standard. It ensures that the environmental impact of operations is being measured and continuously improved, minimising the environmental footprint, diminishing the risk of pollution incidents and improving operating systems. FibreGuard and all FibreGuard mills are ISO 140001 certified.


